'Self-discipline & civic sense crucial to nation building'

The HA College of Commerce organises a workshop on 'The role of youth in today's time'

Around 500 students participated in a workshop titled 'The role of youth in today's time' organised by HA College of Commerce (HACC), on August 14. Dr S.B. Chothani from City Arts College, head of the department of psychology conducted the workshop. "It is important that students learn about loyalty towards the nation. However, one must also inculcate self-discipline and civic sense," said Dr Chothani.

Students were given advice on how they can play an effective role in helping victims of natural disasters, earthquakes and floods. Importance of blood donation was also emphasised in the workshop. Students were also encouraged to visit old age homes.

Dr Chothani stated, "It is in our culture to take care of our parents and we need to continue showing faith in that spirit." Principal of HACC, Sanjay Vakil said, "We are in the 60th year of independence and have no direct involvement in it. But now, as the time students can contribute to the development of the nation. For this, we need to develop leadership qualities." He added, "It can only be developed by joining National Service Scheme (NSS) and National Cadet Corps (NCC). This will develop internal traits, confidence and help talent bloom. It will take us closer to the vision of 2020 by A.P.J Abdul Kalam."

TOUGHENING UP Self-defence training for students to curb crime rate

City Police under 'Suraksha Setu' guided students

The National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of HA College of Commerce (HACC) and Ahmednagar City Police under 'Suraksha Setu' guided the students of the college on mechanisms of self-defence.

ACP Kanan Desai gave a theoretical explanation on how to protect oneself against domestic violence and sexual harassment. He advised the students that it is legally required to have a committee in workplace that includes a member of HCO and police official of the nearby police station. The company also has its members on board.

They were also informed that in case of an awkward incident that results in the filing of a complaint, the report needs to be submitted within 30 days. If the report is not submitted, a complaint can be filed by the concerned person in a police station.

Desai also explained the definition of sexual harassment and informed that it includes shows, missed calls, abusive messages, offering temptations etc. Similarly, acts of dowry death, bad behaviour with the wife or daughter in law, undue ostentation and demoralisation are quality for domestic violence.

Thereafter the police personnel provided training to the attendees. The students learnt that, for instance, if a girl is attacked by a boy then she can use her feet and remove the cap to hurt the legs. This will not be counted as a crime. They explained it was an act of self-defence. The students were also informed on how and where to learn to protect oneself while exercising the maximum impact of it. The students also learnt that 100 and 102 help lines can provide police protection within 10 minutes.

Principal of HACC, Sanjay Vakil said, "It is important to make students aware about the incidents prevailing in the society and how to protect oneself. In my opinion, the educational institutions can play a huge role in deterring crime rates. They can help provide distinguished atmosphere and encourage them to think freely."

Meghani remembered on his birth anniversary

Meghani Memorial Trust and HACC hold event to pay tribute to the legendary poet

Meghani Memorial Committee and All India Democratic Students' Organisation (All India DSO) jointly organised an event to mark the birth anniversary of Jhaverchand Meghani in Meghanagar on Monday. On the occasion, memorial convener Mheerajoshi spoke about the life and struggle of the great poet.

Jayshbhai Patel of Narmad Meghani Library and the volunteers presented songs written by the great visionary poet.

"His songs were magical and would inspire people to join freedom movement. He had a vision about a new society to be formed after the independence. His dream was a society ruled by farmers, mine workers and daily wage earners. He was against caste discrimination," said Joshi.

"He was earning Rs 6,000 as a manager in a company in those days. However, he quit the job and opted for journalism. He visited several villages to learn about folk songs. His lyrics took of modern thoughts. Meghani also paid tribute to Bhanu Prasad, Jhadrnath Das and other



martyrs through his lyrics which would also expose the hypocrisy of so-called religious leaders," said Joshi.

HA College of Commerce (HACC) also organised a lecture on the renowned poet on Friday. The programme started with a discussion on the relevance of his works in today's time. Professor Arvind Vaghela of CU Shah Arts College spoke about the legendary poet and also recited two poems from his collections - "Yuvandans" and "Sinhudor".

"Meghani expressed his patriotism through the words. He depicted the folk culture of Saurashtra in his works. He also translated Rabindranath Tagore's writings. This shows his literary genius," said Vaghela.

Principal Sanjay Vakil said, "How can people of Gujarat not know this literary personality? It is our responsibility to preserve our cultural treasures."

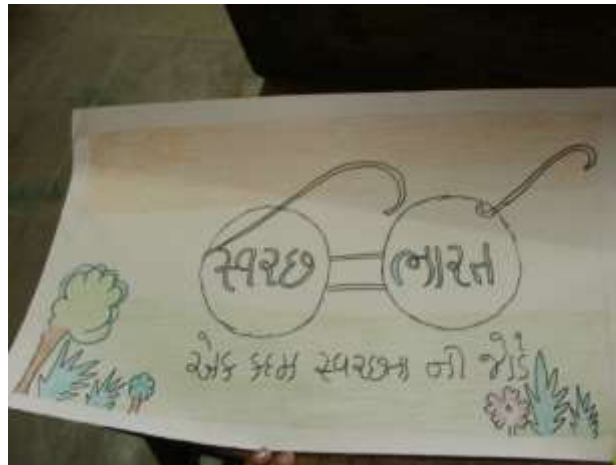

NATIONAL CONFERENCE ON: "THE STATUS OF COMMERCE EDUCATION IN INDIA"

On 2nd January 2016 HACC organized a one day national conference on "The Status of Commerce Education in India". As part of its 60th year anniversary celebrations the college initiated a review and discussion of the condition of commerce education. As the first accredited commerce college in Gujarat, HACC decided to organize a conference on this theme. The conference was inaugurated by Shri Bhupendrasinhji Chudasma, Honorable Minister of Education Gujarat State in the presence of Shri Sudhirbhai Nanavati, Executive Vice-President of Gujarat Law Society and Dr. Parimal Vyas, Vice-Chancellor, M.S University.

As chief guest of the inaugural function, the Honorable Minister expressed his pleasure with GLS and HACC for taking innovative and firm steps towards education in Gujarat. In his presidential address Shri Sudhirbhai nanavati made a very pertinent point when he said that commerce education, more than anything, needs to include one important aspect: Morality. The keynote address delivered by Dr. Parimal Vyas, highlighted the various areas that commerce education need to focus on.

The conference had 300 participants, including students and faculty members. Over thirty papers were presented in the two technical sessions held during the day. The conference proceedings were released in the form of a CD.

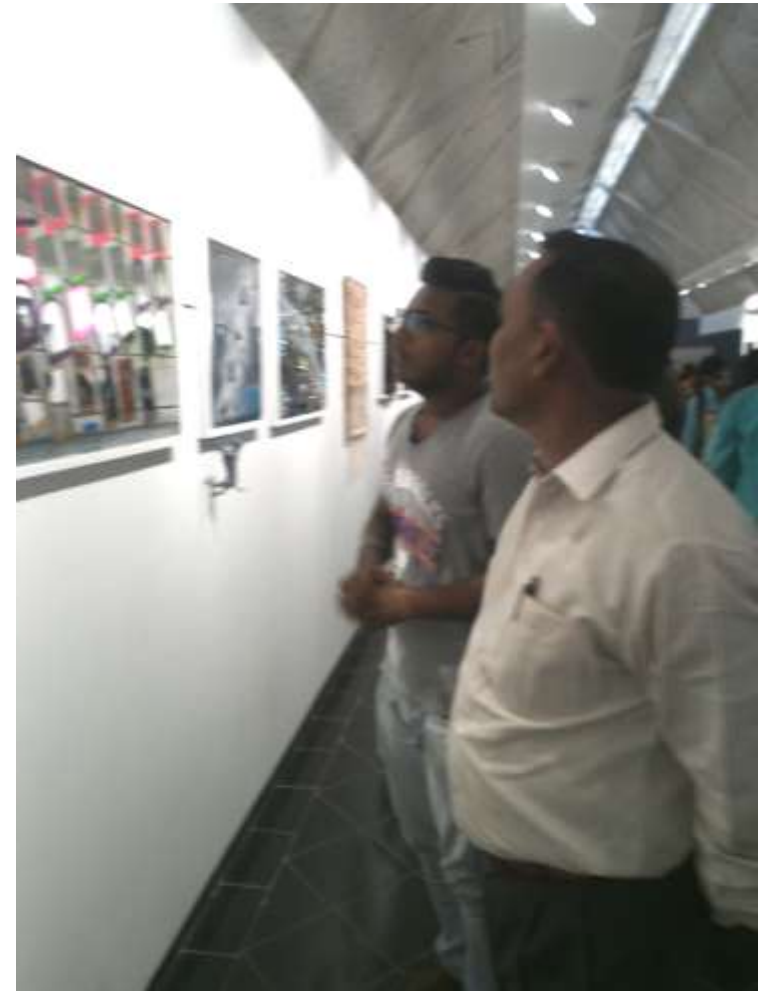
